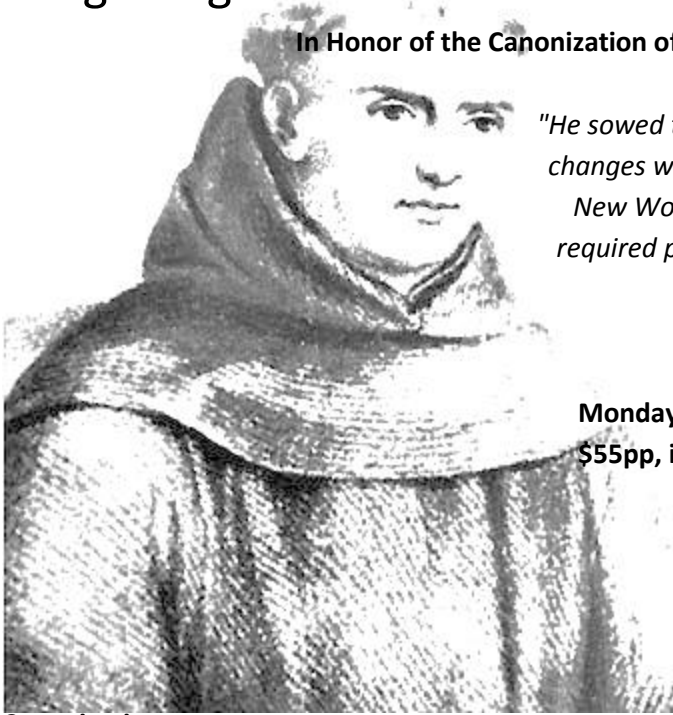
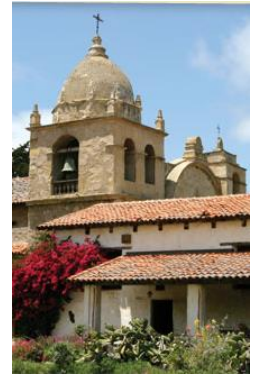


# Pilgrimage to San Carlos Borroméo de Carmelo Mission

In Honor of the Canonization of Blessed Junipero Serra

## Canonization

When Father Junipero Serra died in 1784, he was mourned by the friars and Indians, who referred to him for generations after his death as “el santo” — the saint. On Wednesday, Sept. 23, 2015, however, Blessed Junipero Serra, will be canonized by Pope Francis at the Basilica of the National Shrine of Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. Father Serra will be the first native saint from the Balearic Islands and the first saint to be canonized on U.S. soil.

## Pilgrimage

In honor of Blessed Junipero Serra and in celebration of his canonization, all are invited to participate in a one-day pilgrimage to San Carlos Borroméo del Rio Carmelo Mission where his remains are buried, marked with an inscription in the floor of the sanctuary. The Carmel Mission was founded at its present site in 1771 by Father Junipero Serra and was once the headquarters for the entire California mission system.

Travelling by chartered bus, pilgrims will leave Our Lady of Peace Church at 7a.m. (coffee service provided for early arrivals). A movie on the life of Blessed Junipero Serra will be shown on the drive to Carmel. Pilgrims will begin their visit to Carmel with a private Mass at 10:00a.m., followed by a docent lead tour of the beautiful garden, abalone-strewn cemetery, and museums (via the Carmel Mission Docent Association-CMDA). The Basilica Church, registered as a National Historic Landmark and the centerpiece of the mission, displays a fine collection of Spanish Colonial Liturgical Art and Artifacts. In Convento Museum, you will find the cell used by Blessed Junipero Serra and where he died in 1784. You can peer into Father Serra's spartan living quarters — a table, chair and a highly uncomfortable-looking

wooden bed — and check out his book collection, identified as “California's first library.”

To further understand the history of this beautiful heritage site, three other museums are included in the tour: 1) The Harry Downie Museum with interpretive displays and artifacts devoted to telling the restoration story of the Mission, 2) The Munrás Family Heritage Museum with treasured keepsakes of one prominent Monterey family, and 3) The Jo Mora Chapel Gallery housing the elaborate Serra Memorial Cenotaph, sculpted in 1924 by Catalan sculptor Joseph A. Mora, of travertine marble and bronze.

## Lunch & Seaside Excursion

Nestled between Monterey and Carmel, in the town of Pacific Grove, is a charming little park by the ocean where travellers will be treated to a beach-side surf-n-turf lunch (burgers and chowder). Free-time is provided to walk along the beach, coastal trails, and/or rent a bike, before boarding the bus and returning to Our Lady of Peace Church.
