From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Since in these days many of our children are beginning the school year, it seemed opportune to me to say few words on the right and duty of parents regarding the education of their children continuing with the always up-to-date teachings of *Familiaris Consortio*.

It says: "The task of giving education is rooted in the primary vocation of married couples to participate in God's creative activity: by begetting in love and for love a new person who has within himself or herself the vocation to growth and development, parents by that very fact take on the task of helping that person effectively to live a fully human life... Their role as educators is so decisive that scarcely anything can compensate for their failure in it." (36)

Yes, parents are educators because they are parents. And while it is true that they share their mission with other individuals or with the school, it remains their primary task. The duty is non-delegable. The parent is ultimately responsible for his or her child. Importantly, this is a task shared by both parents, and so "the role of the father and that of the mother are equally necessary," says the Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Catholic Church. (242)

In his *Letter to Families*, written in 1994, St. John Paul II asserts: "To give birth according to the flesh means to set in motion a further 'birth', one which is gradual and complex and which continues in the whole process of education." Therefore, parents are also called to 'honor' their children, whether they are young or old. And this 'principle of giving honor' –states the Pope– is the basic condition for every authentic educational process.

The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church also insists that the family's educational rights include the notion of "integral education." This includes the mandate that all education be directed to the proper formation of the human person "in view of his final end." It requires recognition of the virtues "of justice and charity." (*Compendium*, 242)

This means that a God-less education is unacceptable. Man's final end is God, and inculcation of the virtue of justice and charity demand a theistic philosophy of education.

We should also mention that the family "is not the exclusive educating community." (*Familiaris Consortio*, 40)

"The State and the Church have the obligation to give families all possible aid to enable them to perform their educational role properly. Therefore both the Church and the State must create and foster the institutions and activities that families justly demand, and the aid must be in proportion to the families' needs." (*Familiaris Consortio*, 40)

Nowadays, however, it isn't surprising, due to the secularism of our times, that many assume that the primary goal of education is to form students for citizenship. The assumption, however, is a fundamental violation of the order of things. The State is subordinate to God, and to the Truth, Goodness, and Justice that point to God and are necessary for human flourishing. (Cf. Johnathan Beeson, *What is Classical Catholic Education?*) Instead, we maintain that the primary purpose of education is to form students for the *civitas Dei* (the city of God).

Dear Parents, I know that you work very hard and make many sacrifices to offer your child a good education. Remember that education is "an act of hope," as Pope Francis says, so never give up trying your very best.

To all the children and youth who begin a new school year, I'll give you as advice the wise words that St. Louis King of France gave to his son: "Set your heart to love God; for unless one loves God none can be saved. Keep yourself from doing anything that is displeasing to God that is to say, from mortal sin."

I wish you all –parents, teachers, schools' staff, and students– a beautiful journey at school.

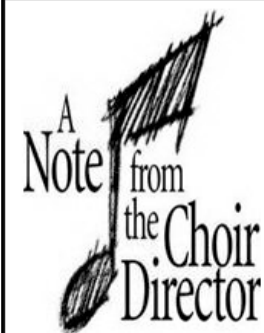

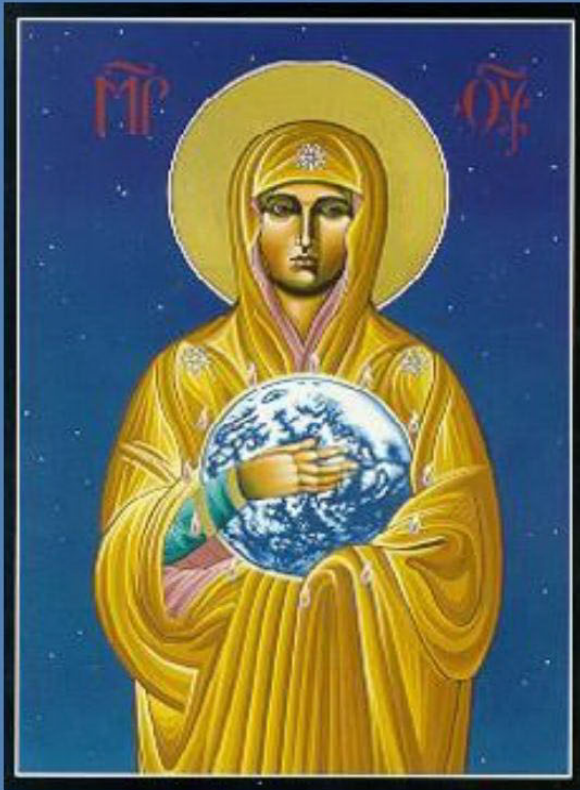
INSTRUCTION ON MUSIC IN THE LITURGY

18. Among the faithful, special attention must be given to the instruction in sacred singing of members of lay religious societies, so that they may support and promote the participation of the people more effectively.[18] The formation of the whole people in singing, should be seriously and patiently undertaken together with liturgical instruction, according to the age, status and way of life of the faithful and the degree of their religious culture; this should be done even from the first years of education in elementary schools.
