From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Following the invitation of our Holy Father to instruct and encourage the youth to rediscover the beauty of the human vocation to love, providing them the arguments they need to *rise* “against the widespread tendency to reduce love to something banal, reducing it to its sexual aspect alone, deprived of its essential characteristics of beauty, communion, fidelity and responsibility” (*Message for the XXX World Youth Day, 01/31/15*) our Parish is happy to invite you all to **RISE! 2015**.

The **RISE! 2015** Conference is a two-day event that will take place this coming Friday 13th and Saturday 14th. It consists of a series of talks by keynote speakers (*Matt Fradd and Jackie Francois*), participation in the Holy Mass, opportunity for Confession, fellowship, and fun! We'll have one night for adults, a day for teens and an entire evening for young adults. (Please check the program or visit www.riseba.org for each day schedule.) Remember that this event is absolutely free but requires previous registration (except for the young adult's talks.) Spread the word and invite your family and friends!

Now, the underlining thread of all the conferences is this sentence from our Lord: ***Rise, and do not be afraid.*** (Mt 17:7)

Our Holy Father has invited us on several occasions: “not be afraid of what God is asking of us” and “not to be afraid of true love”; keeping in mind that –as he himself said- to be *pure in heart* (Mt 5:8) is a guarantee of our happiness. And Pope Francis explained how is it that blessedness comes about through purity of heart.

He wrote: “Youth is a time of life when your desire for a love which is genuine, beautiful and expansive begins to blossom in your hearts. How powerful is this ability to love and to be loved! Do not let this precious treasure be debased, destroyed or spoiled. That is what happens when we start to use our neighbors for our own selfish ends, even as objects of pleasure. Hearts are broken and sadness follows upon these negative experiences. I urge you: Do not be afraid of true love, the love that Jesus teaches us and which Saint Paul describes as *patient and kind*. Paul says: *Love is not jealous or boastful; it is not arrogant or rude. Love does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrong, but rejoices in the right. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things* (1 Cor 13:4-8).” (*Message for the XXX World Youth Day*)

Then, in another occasion, he's said: “God calls you to make definitive choices, and he has a plan for each of you: to discover that plan and to respond to your vocation is to move toward personal fulfilment. God calls each of us to be holy, to live his life, but he has a particular path for each one of us. Some are called to holiness through family life in the sacrament of Marriage. Today, there are those who say that marriage is out of fashion. Is it out of fashion? In a culture of relativism and the ephemeral, many preach the importance of “enjoying” the moment. They say that it is not worth making a life-long commitment, making a definitive decision, “for ever”, because we do not know what tomorrow will bring. I ask you, instead, to be revolutionaries, I ask you to swim against the tide; yes, I am asking you to rebel against this culture that sees everything as temporary and that ultimately believes you are incapable of responsibility, that believes you are incapable of true love. I have confidence in you and I pray for you. Have the courage “to swim against the tide”. And also have the courage to be happy.” (*Meeting with the Volunteers of the XXVIII Word Youth Day, 28 July 2013*).

Thus, he invited us all to be “brave adventurers! Allowing ourselves to discover the rich teachings of the Church on love, because it is then that we will discover that Christianity does not consist of a series of prohibitions which stifle our desire for happiness, but rather a project for life capable of captivating our hearts.” (Cf. *Message for the XXX World Youth Day*) This is the invitation we extend to you today!

My deepest gratitude to all those who helped organize and promote this event as well as to all the volunteers that will be working during those days. May God reward you abundantly! And may the maternal gaze of the Blessed Virgin Mary, full of grace, all-beautiful and all-pure, accompany us at every step along the way.

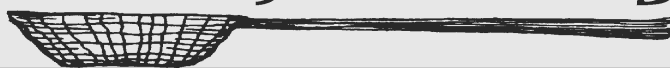

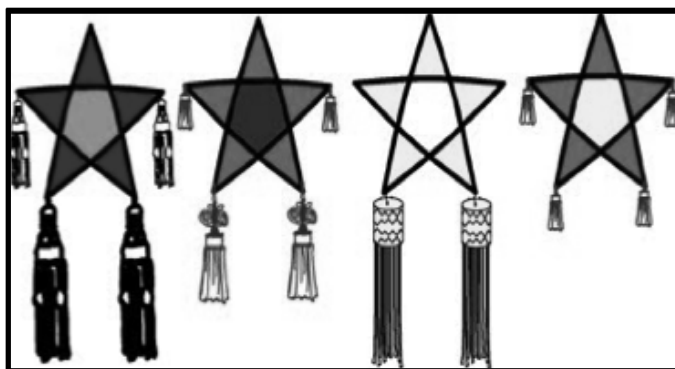

Freedom and the Child

"The education of liberty in a child must possess two qualities: first, it must be **gradual**; second, it must be associated with the **moral order**. It must appeal to the conscience of the educator and also to the one who is educated.

There should be a gradual unfolding of liberty according to the age of the child. In infancy, this liberty is developed sometimes by sheer **imitation** or by **suggestion** which prompts the child to act spontaneously or as if he did not feel that any order was being given.

The peak of moral authority is reflected in the attitude of the parent who says: "I ask for **obedience**, because I am **responsible before God for you**." The child in his turn, if morally educated, will have in his heart the sentiment: "I will obey my parents because **they take the place of God in my home**." Where there is love, there is obedience;

where there is obedience, there is the discovery of the secrets of happiness." (from *Children and*

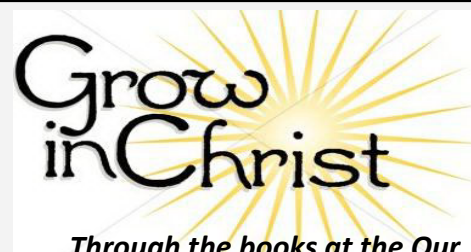

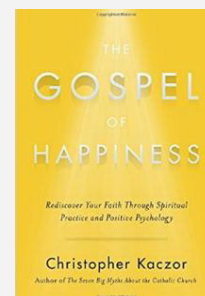
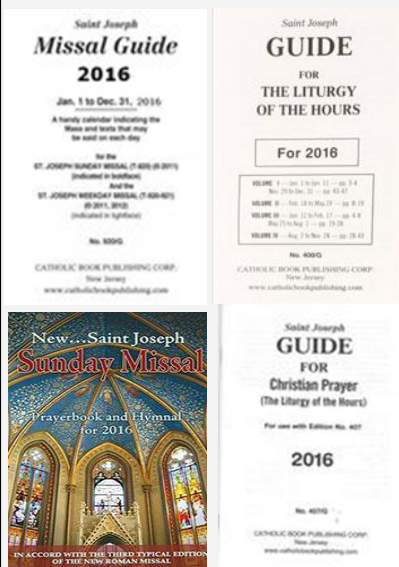

The Gospel of Happiness: Rediscover Your Faith Through Spiritual Practice & Positive Psychology, – Christopher Kaczor

Professor Kaczor has distilled the findings of positive psychology on the subject of happiness, showing their congruence with Christian

theology.
