From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Our Lady of Peace Shrine is a *place of pilgrimage and prayer with*: . . . frequent celebration of the Sacraments, particularly the Eucharist and Reconciliation.

I would like to begin by sharing a simple but very important remark that is so often made to me about Our Lady of Peace: "You are the church that is open." What a simple but profound reality. It seems clear to me that, in addition to the legacy of Eucharistic Adoration and Marian Devotion, one of the most important qualities that our parish enjoys is being "the church that is open 24/7." People come to seek Jesus and they know that they will find him – in the blessed sacrament, in the celebration of the Holy Mass, and in the Confessional.

In an interview with Mother Angelica on November 1, 1998, Fr. Sweeny, referring to the availability of the sacraments, explained that continuity is so important, "What I find that is most important is continuity, it is like a spring . . . you can count on it. That the church provides something that is consistent. I can go there and it is open or that there are priests in the confessional." Everyone is searching for peace in their hearts and it is most powerfully and intimately experienced through the words: This is my body & this is my blood, and I absolve you of your sins. More souls of the faithful in grace and more grace in the souls of the faithful. As the Catechism explains, "The sacraments are efficacious signs of grace, instituted by Christ and entrusted to the Church, by which divine life is dispensed to us." (CCC 1131) Everyone is in the search for peace, not a mere temporary or ephemeral peace, but rather unchanging, everlasting, and authentic peace—an encounter with the Divine.

One of the simple truths of the Gospel accounts of Jesus is that no one simply walks away from an encounter with Jesus Christ unchanged. Moreover, as the Church has so often taught, the desire to encounter the Lord is already a fruit of His grace. He is drawing souls to himself and souls by their very nature are longing for Him. The frequent celebration of the sacraments and the accessibility to the divine life is a necessity of the church (our Parish), because it is meant to be the place of exchange between God and man, the shelter amidst the storm, the intersection between time and eternity, the place where the pilgrim rests and recharges to continue along his journey.

God wants to give us His grace. He wants to fortify, strengthen and to heal us. This is a fact. Through the sacraments Christ gives Christians sanctifying grace, a share in his own life, He always does his part. Our work is to celebrate the sacraments the way in which God wants, with the dispositions that he wants us to have. Sacraments, work on their own power (ex opera operato), therefore do not work like magic. They convey a reality, but our interior state, humility, mindful reception and faith are all necessary dispositions for the sacraments to be received more and more fruitfully. Indifference and mechanical reception will yield little fruit. Humble, devout, and worthy reception yields increasing fruit. "The tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.'" (Luke 18,13) "And those are the ones on whom seed was sown on the good soil; and they hear the word and accept it and bear fruit, thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold (Mark 4:20)."

Through the sacraments, even though man has turned away from God time and again, God reaches out to man to bring him back to Himself. We simply need to invite people to this encounter and allow the Holy Spirit to begin to work in the lives of His beloved creatures. May we continue lead and be led to the participation in the very divine life of God—united by faith and Baptism to the Passion and Resurrection of Christ.
