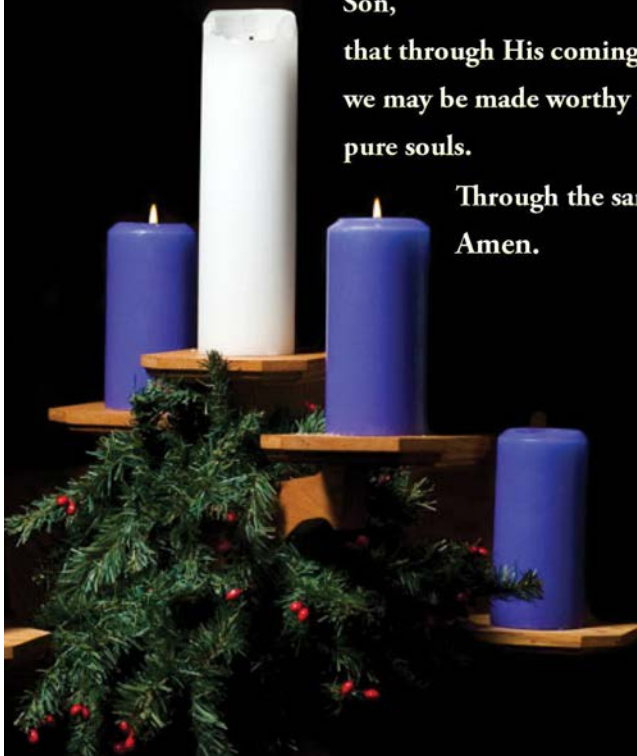

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

"O come let us adore him, O come let us adore him Christ the Lord!" In just a few short weeks, this song will be proclaimed by our voices. We will be singing the refrain of *O Come, All Ye Faithful*, as we celebrate Christmas and the birth of our Lord. Advent is the time of preparation for that great celebration for the coming of our Lord. Every year as Christians we take time, in reverence and humility, to prepare ourselves and reflect on the fact that God has chosen to become human. On the mass of the day, of Christmas Day, we read from prologue of St. John's Gospel as it states "the Word became flesh and made its dwelling among us." (John 1:14) The mystery of the Incarnation, which began with His conception at the Annunciation and then entered more fully through birth at Christmas, and as we gather at the Lord's altar, the Word becomes flesh, substantially, really, and truly present in the Eucharist. Just as we are present to one another in this moment, so our Lord is present in a mysterious way in the appearances of that consecrated, fragile, and simple host. Because of this, we adore! We adore the Lord at Mass and we have the opportunity here at Our Lady of Peace to adore the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration.

For more than 40 years, we have been able to adore and behold our Lord 24 hours a day, to behold our Lord and adore. For 168 hours a week, the parishioners of Our Lady of Peace are placing themselves before the Lord in prayer and adoration.

This moment of Advent is a moment in which we can rediscover (or discover for the first time) the wonder of Eucharistic adoration. If you have never come to spend time with our Lord, please consider it. It is a precious gift that you can personally, freely, lovingly offer to our Lord, a moment of yourself and your precious time—whether it is during the day or the hours of the night, to be with our Lord and to adore Him. I invite you to consider those blessings that come to us in such an encounter.

During Advent, there are some recurring themes, in light of Eucharistic adoration I want to consider two. First, we are called in this season to cultivate a spirit of watchfulness and readiness. There will be a time in which the son of man will come again and we will stand before Him. When the time to welcome Him again, what does Jesus tell us to do? The Master Himself says: "Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent and to stand before the Son of Man." Our Lord says if we are in a right relationship with Him than we have nothing to fear. My friends, might it be the case that we will only be able to respond to Jesus's invitation to stand before Him only after we have knelt before Him in adoration of His presence in the Eucharist. In that intimate hour of prayer, we can spend and find that time with the Lord to be strengthened in our life's tribulations – against the enemy's attacks.

Secondly, in this season there is a call to repent and turn towards the Gospel, which is conversion. Looking at Christ and allowing Him to look at you is a powerful moment of conversion. Jesus Himself said, "for my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in Him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day" (Jn 6:40). We all are seeking the face of God. Consider that these words, "He looked at him and loved him," (Mk 10:21) apply to each one of us, we should simply come and allow Him to look at us. And prayer, teaches the Catechism, is above all (on our part) the response to an invitation. We go and visit Him, because He has loved us first. (Cf., CCC 2567, 1 Jn 4:19) There is something within us that seeks the face of God and desires that look of love that alone can heal and perfect us. Come to visit Him, come let us adore Him.

Mary, Our Lady of Peace, pray for us!

Our Lady of Peace Annual Financial Report (Fiscal Year 2015-16)

This annual report is a summary of a several page report submitted to the Diocese this year to show our actual income and expenses compared to what was budgeted for Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

Maximum Transparency

In order to support maximum transparency, the Diocese has access to our books, we send them a detailed financial Budget vs Actual Report each year, and we are audited by third-party accountants. In this same light, we send you this summary for reference but anyone wishing to see the full report may contact the rectory office and make an appointment.

What the numbers mean

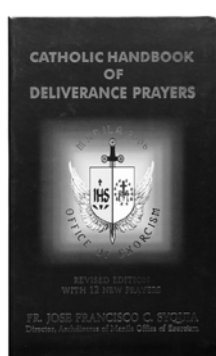
Net Income was \$108,341 over budget mostly because of continued growth of the Parish resulting in larger collections and donations as well as more expense in religious education, liturgy and other projects and programs.

An increase in other Parish projects and programs includes \$94,968 spent on the development of the Master Plan and \$100,125 spent on special Shrine and Parish events throughout the year including the RISE Conference.

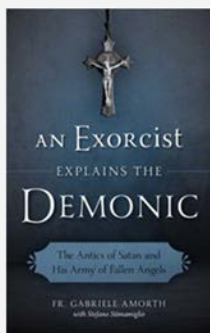

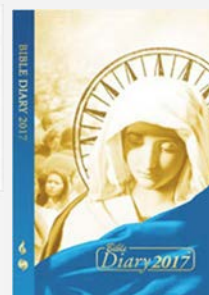
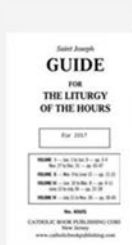
