

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

This month is marked by many different activities, Mother's Day, confirmations, but there is one event that I wanted to speak about and especially to those who will be affected by it – First Holy Communion. Presuming very few actually read this little weekly column, and maybe 0.001% of our 7-10 year olds have ever read it, I am depending upon you who have decided to start reading this today to pass it along to a First Communicants this week. It's for them . . . mostly.

Remember the date of your first communion! For some of you it will be May 13, others May 20th or for others May 27th. Remember it well. This day you are receiving Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist as your First Holy Communion, a day to be remembered as one of life's most beautiful.

I want you to see it as the very best gift that God can ever give you. You may have already asked Him for things in your prayers; if not, be sure that in the future there will be times that you will ask Him for something. Do not forget this: He, through the Eucharist, gives you the absolute best He can offer and something far better than we could ever imagine – He gives us Himself!!!

Oftentimes, when we want to do something nice for someone we write them a letter, or paint them a picture, or save up our money and buy them something nice, all of these gifts represent something inside of us that we want to express to the one's we care about. (Hopefully you did something like this for your mom, since its Mother's day!) Jesus gives us everything in the Eucharist. Jesus is God's love letter personally written to each one of us. Jesus is the beautiful work of Art of the Father. Jesus is the most precious gift and He paid for the gift He offers us with His own life.

Jesus is much like you who are young – childlikeness is a beautiful thing that you should always preserve. For Him, it is ALWAYS special to give Himself to us, every time that any one of us receives Him in the Eucharist is so special for Him. Think of it this way, Jesus treats every communion with us as special and unique and wonderful as we treat the first one. Because for Him, He never gets bored in sharing His love with us, in fact, this is what He wants – to love us and to be loved by us. This is who He is, Love; and this is what we are made for, Love.

When are we most happy? When we do that for which we are made, as the bird is happiest flying and the fish happiest swimming. Then there is a thrill and a fullness to life. You children are full of life; and you love repetition. For example, when I swing my nephew – He keeps telling me, “more, more, . . . higher, higher.” (And then my arms get tired and I have to quit, because I'm old!) And because God is like a child, He says over and over, “let's do it again!” He is this way with us in Holy Communion, each time that we receive Him is a moment of great joy for Him, every time we go and visit Him in the Eucharist at the Church, just to say hello, it consoles His heart. Therefore, when it comes to the Communion that you receive and the fact that you can now receive Jesus when you go into the communion line – do not let it get old! Allow your childlikeness to shine forth and ask Mary to accompany you every time you go to receive her son.

Dear friends, please know that your life is meant for a real and living relationship with Jesus, and remember this as you receive him the second time, the third time, the 1,659th time! And that our life is a wonderful adventure when we live each day to become closer to God. When you have said your prayers, when you have offered your actions in union with God, continue to enjoy the thrill of repetition and say “let's do it again!”

May God bless you and keep you close to His Sacred Heart and Blessed Mother Mary.

The Immaculate Heart of Our Lady of Fatima statue was designed as she appeared in 1929 to St. Lucia in Tuy, Spain. It was during this apparition that Our Lady asked for the consecration to Russia to her Immaculate Heart. The statue was blessed by Pope Francis on October 23, 2013. It was formally introduced at the 2014 March for Life in Washington, D.C., and has been visiting parishes around the U.S. since then.

Are You a Registered Parishioner?

If you attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church.

Three main reasons why registering is important:

1. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

This includes single people or young families who may not see the need to register.

2. Registering in the parish makes Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

Infant baptisms, religious education registration, being a godparent/sponsor for baptisms or confirmations, and especially getting married whether you are getting married at this parish, another parish, or having an international Catholic wedding. If you're not a registered parishioner, this will greatly delay the process.

3. Letters of Recommendation

Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide this letter to you or your family.

Anyone, regardless of where they live (and even though the Diocese is divided into parish geographical areas), is welcome to register at OLOP. Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork will not be processed within the 3 months.


FEED THE NEED
