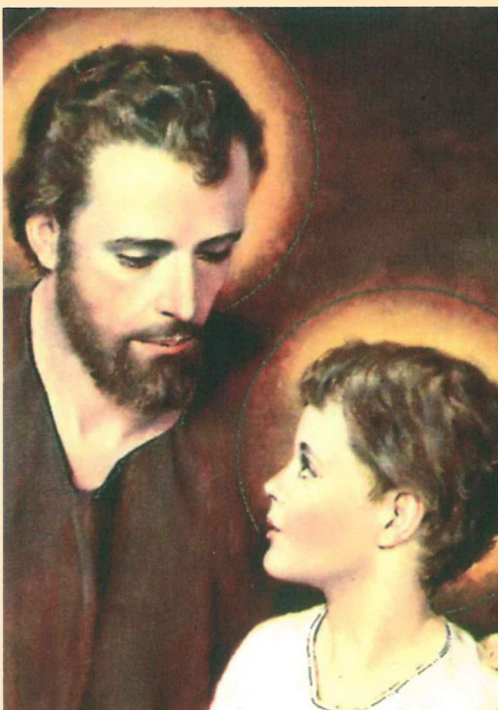

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

As we celebrate Father's Day, I wanted to base our reflection upon a beautiful letter written by St. John of Avila to Fray Luis de Granada in the 16th Century. He helps us to understand that fatherhood is something much greater than the bond of flesh and blood, but it is one that is bound by a much deeper and sacred one: charity.

If we are to summarize his thoughts into a single line it would be this: *the true father must die to himself, so that his child may live.*

"How much **wisdom** he needs to bring the child back once he has fallen. **Patience**, so he does not get tired of hearing the same questions over and over again which he has heard and responded to a thousand times, and so that he can explain again what he has already said before. What **constant and courageous praying** he must do to God, begging that his child not die!" (St. John of Avila, *Letter to Fray Luis of Granada*, v. 20-21)

Regarding **wisdom** and a parent's responsibility to safeguard truth, Pope Paul VI explains it well in *Humanae Vitae*: "Responsible parenthood, as we use the term here, has one further essential aspect of paramount importance. It concerns the objective moral order which was established by God, and of which a right conscience is the true interpreter. In a word, the exercise of responsible parenthood requires that husband and wife, keeping a right order of priorities, recognize their own duties toward God, themselves, their families and human society." (*Humanae vitae*, no. 10)

Patience, is something that is of course easier preached than practiced, but we must remember that the moments of interaction with one's children are priceless and they are ir retrievable. St. John of Avila says: "even though sometimes the father's heart might be tormented with a thousand concerns, so that he needs, for his own tranquility, . . . when his child comes, he still must play and laugh with him, as if the child was his sole focus."

And lastly, **prayer is vital**. A father must be a man of prayer. Prayer is so necessary that it should even precede all dealings with your children (note: I said precede, not *preclude*). The spiritual life of a dad is a life of intimacy with God, a life of daily contact with the Eternal Father through prayer and meditation (yes, meditation!). This meeting with God and with His fatherly love for everyone brings us face to face with the need to be there for our children, to give ourselves to them, to offer ourselves to our bride and family in a humble and disinterested fashion – always and exclusively for them. A father, much like a priest, must be a man for others. This relationship with God the Father will be deepened most greatly through the perfect prayer, where God gives Himself to us entirely, humbly, and lovingly, which is the Holy Mass. The Eucharistic Bread, with the Word of God, nourishes the soul, guides us and leads us, heals us and revitalizes us – it is a father's moment to learn from his Father.

Therefore, concludes St. John of Avila, "he who desires to be a father is greatly helped by having a gentle heart, a heart of flesh, so as to be compassionate toward his sons (which is a martyrdom in itself), and another heart of iron, in order to suffer the blows that their death will bring, so that the father will not stumble nor be driven to leave his office, nor faint, nor spend days just crying." (St. John of Avila, *Letter*, v. 20-21)

So between last week and this week, what can we take away? The world, our societies, and above all our homes, need faithful Catholic men, men who desire to be saints. This is a cornerstone in the domestic church, the husband and the father who sacrifices his own desires out of love to be at the service of his wife and his children.

Mary Mother of God Mission Society

June 23rd & 24th

On the weekend of June 23/24, Fr. Daniel Maurer, C.J.D., from the Most Holy Mother of God parish in Vladivostok, Russia, will visit our parish to speak about the Roman Catholic Mission Churches in Eastern Russia. A second offering will be taken for the missions.

In the early 1900's, the Russian Far East boasted a thriving Roman Catholic population. Many Russians, Poles, Lithuanians, and other groups inhabited the area and had built schools, hospitals, and beautiful churches.

After the revolution of 1917, Russia became an emblem of the Communist era, a land without churches and without God. Under Stalin, all Catholic churches were confiscated and Dioceses closed. Most churches were desecrated or destroyed. Catholics were murdered by the hundreds of thousands and their bodies dumped into mass graves. In 1991, the Soviet Union ceased to exist, leaving Russia and 15 other countries as independent nations.

Our two American priests, Fr. Myron Effing, CJD, and Fr. Daniel Maurer, CJD, arrived in Vladivostok in 1992 to help re-establish the Church in this region and provide charitable assistance to the many poor. Since then—and with the mission society's help—they have founded or re-founded 11 Catholic parishes, have developed numerous charitable initiatives, have created a variety of catechetical programs, and done much more.

Now that the foundations have been laid, additional priests and sisters are joining the work, and parishes are growing and multiplying, very slowly, but surely.

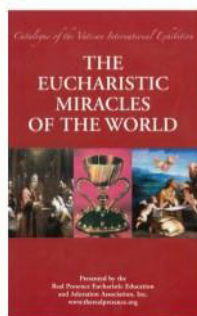
Defying Gravity
