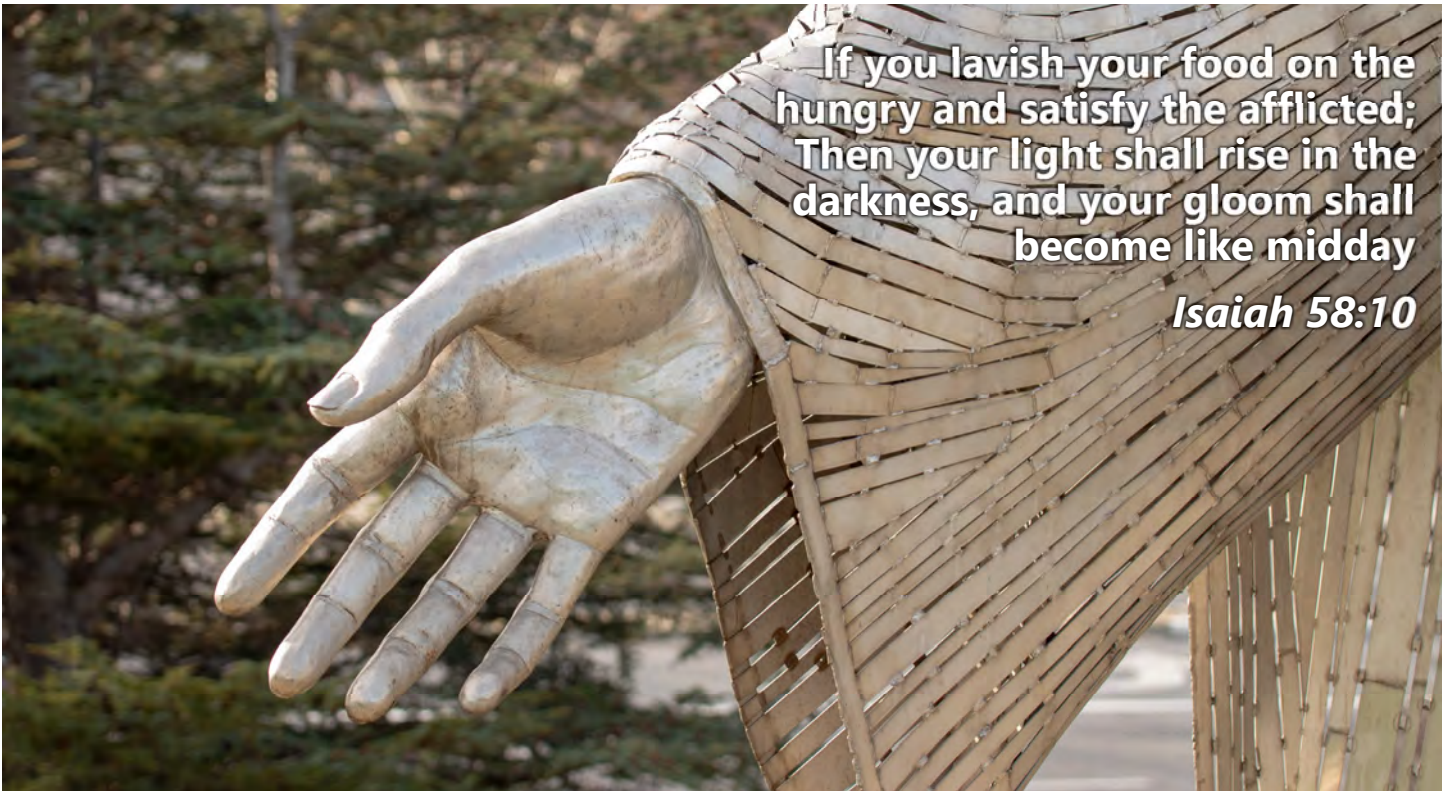

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

The theme for this year's Annual diocesan appeal is **"Encountering Christ, Faith in Action."** In light of this, the Gospel account of the rich young man comes to mind. This was an encounter with Jesus. The young man was so caught up in this encounter that he runs up to Him, kneels before Him and asks Him the question of all questions: "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" What does Jesus respond? "Have you fulfilled your duties? Do you keep the commandments? Do you honor your father and mother?" Yes, he fulfills them, yet he now admits to Jesus he desires more. He says "What more must I do? Beyond my duties, obligations and commitments", he asks, "what more must I do?" His heart had opened up, begging for *faith in action*. We know what happened, he had attachments to his things which left him sad, but the encounter prompted action. Encountering Christ prompts us to take another step. The question is no longer what do I have to do, but it becomes a perpetual "What more can I do?"

With perpetual adoration, the frequent reception of the Sacraments, with the gentle prompting of His Blessed Mother, Christ is encountered here at Our Lady of Peace. He is accessible. From this encounter however, we must not dismiss, the invitation that results, "follow me."

The works of the Diocese supported by the Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA) are an effective and concrete means of following Him and putting our faith in action. In support of the ADA, one can begin to respond to the question "What else can I do?"

The Our Lady of Peace Parish goal for 2020 is \$ 342,077.

In order to reach this goal, I encourage each and every family in Our Lady of Peace Parish to take part in this effort and prayerfully consider pledging slightly more than you pledged last year. If you did not pledge last year, we ask you to help with your share of our community obligation. Of the thousands of adults who attend Mass at Our Lady of Peace Church, we are asking for at least 800 of you to pledge \$50/month for 10 months. If you can sacrifice more than the tax-deductible \$50/month, we will surely surpass our goal and that surplus will return to Our Lady of Peace Church ensuring the well-functioning of all of our own programs and more. Remember that no gift made out of love and inspired by faith is too small.

I am grateful to personally witness the generosity of so many individuals and families who concretely and faithfully seek to put their faith into action. There is a long-standing tradition here of extending the grace of God, proclaiming and teaching His Truth, and celebrating His Mysteries as a faith-filled community. Let us, however, press on!

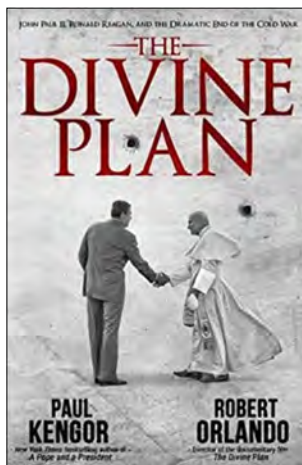

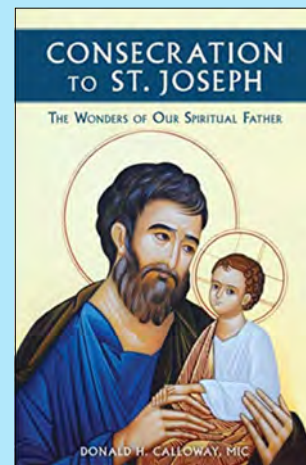
