

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### *Conversations On Culture: A Garden Variety*

Dear Friends,

In the back of the rectory with the help of a friend, I am trying to grow some lettuce and jalapeño plants in order to, you guessed it, make spicy salads! Why would I bring this up when striving to keep up a conversation on culture? I would say that it has a lot to do with culture; it illustrates an important point in this regard. I will get to it in a moment.

At the very beginning of his work on education titled *The Closing of the American Mind*, Prof. Alan Bloom says, "There is one thing a professor can be absolutely certain of: almost every student entering the university believes, or says they believe, that truth is relative." He says they are so entrenched in this that they are not afraid of error, but intolerance. According to him the students hold that "relativism is necessary to openness; and this is the virtue, the only virtue, which all primary education for more than fifty years has dedicated itself to inculcating. Openness—and the relativism that makes it the only plausible stance in the face of various claims to truth and various ways of life and kinds of human beings—is the great insight of our times. [...] The point is not to correct the mistakes and really be right; rather it is not to think you are right at all."

To put it another way, let us look at what John Senior calls it. In his work titled *Death of a Christian Culture*, he says that one of the essential characteristics of Modernism is *artificiality*. What does he mean by this? Well, it is similar to relativism. It simply means to be cut off from reality or as Senior puts it, "a dis-realization of the universe." If everything is relative to an individual, he is free to make up things as he wants or imagines. The only thing that really matters is that it be new, cut off from reality. Senior says that the driving force behind Modernism, similar to the idea of "openness" is the "perpetual urge for the new—not the real, not the true, not the ideal, not even the evil, . . . but all these things for the sake of the new."

The consequences of cultural relativism leave us weak and atrophied, impulsive and divisive, how could it not?

Let us return to the garden so I can introduce it to you as a real life example of objectivity. You need to do certain things for a plant to thrive. If you do not do those things, it will shrivel up and die. What if I turn on some Bach and have it playing for my lettuce? Will this help? No. It will probably not help it grow, no matter what. Now, if I am providing them sunlight and water, not too much and not too little, they should do great. And they are! Some things help growth, some do nothing, and others hurt it.

As humans, some things are good for us and some things are not. Plain and simple. I often use the example of a large bowl of broccoli versus a large bucket of ice cream. Independent of what I think about the two allotments of food, one is the healthier option.

Isn't this a bit much for a Sunday bulletin installment? Yes, I will admit, it probably is a bit much. Nevertheless, I invite you to grab a cup of coffee, turn on some Bach music and think about this stuff. Think about the trends in our culture. At the very least consider this, if the rules of objectivity apply to everything else in the world, why would there not be things that are objectively good or bad for me? If the cosmos has all kinds of laws permeated throughout it, why would the same not apply to the human order and those things that pertain to it? What about commitment and a sense of moral responsibility? Why do so few lack religious motivation? Or patriotism? These types of things are culturally determined. Do I spend more time in the virtual world compared with the real world around me? Do the movies I watch, or the friends that I hang out with, or the music I listen to affect me? Do they help me grow and thrive? What is growing or thriving? Is it simply up to me to decide?

Big questions, I know, but I think we can all agree this is important. Why? Well, because if we go back to our bowls of broccoli and ice cream, no matter how much I imagine it to be, or want it to be, the broccoli will be the healthier choice for my body. Or taking the examples of the plants in the garden, there are objective rules that I have to follow, otherwise the plants will die. Yes, if I only play Bach music around the plants, they will die. I'm sorry. They need water and sunlight, not too much and not too little. The same principle can be applied to me. My humanity needs to be cultivated and there are ways to go about it.



The calendar is currently open for Mass intention requests for the months of November & December! (Please continue to check for updates as we adapt to new changes).

Please follow the **temporary** process listed below.

Although the parish office is closed to drop-in visitors, we have instituted a temporary process to accept and process Mass Intention requests via email. The normal Mass Intention guidelines listed below still apply, including the 25 character limit.

Mass Intention request requirements:

- Donation of \$10 per Mass
- Up to two (2) separate Masses that do not occur in the same week may be requested
- Each Mass may only have 2 names with a limit of 25 characters (including spaces) per Mass request, and only one intention option chosen (Birthday, Death Anniversary, Health, Special Intentions, Thanksgiving, or Wedding Anniversary). Please remember to note if the request is for someone living or deceased.
- No changes can be made once the requests have been placed into the calendar.
- No holds or reservations will be accepted. No exceptions can be made.

In order to request a Mass Intention during this shelter-in time, please carefully follow the steps below:

1. First, please send an email with your full name, phone number, Mass Intention request text (limit 25 characters), and preferred date/time to [mass@olop-shrine.org](mailto:mass@olop-shrine.org). Please refer to the Mass Intention Requests form above to see what details you will need to provide.
2. Once the email is received, our staff will look through the calendar for availability. Until the intention request is finalized by a confirmation reply email from our staff, the intention is not considered entered in the calendar.
3. If there is a time conflict with the requested date/time, our staff member will call you from a private number to arrange an alternative date and time. You will also receive a call if there are any changes needed to the request.
4. The confirmation email will give a link indicating how to submit your Mass Intention request donation online.

**Mass Outside the Church:** Please form a line before Mass begins. Please follow the instructions of the volunteer ushers who will be helping direct you to your places.

- You are encouraged to bring your own chairs if sitting outside.
- You will be instructed to maintain a social distance

between the households (6ft). The chairs have been placed at a distance for distance.

- Children must always remain under the close supervision of parents/family at all times.
- Please dress warmly and be prepared for weather changes!
- There is no reservation system for outdoor Mass.

**Mass in the parking lot:** The only entrance/exit will be from Our Lady's Way. There will be a security guard and volunteers who will direct you to your parking spots.

- Please stay in your vehicles at all times, unless you need to line up for confession or use the restroom. The restrooms that are designated for public use are only in the Family Learning Center.
- We will broadcast the Mass on an FM radio signal (92.9 FM) so that you can follow along from your vehicle.
- Due to county restrictions, Mass is limited to 100 cars only. Holy Communion can only be distributed to those in their vehicles in the parking lot participating in the Mass.
- Please turn on your emergency blinker lights at the appropriate to indicate that you wish to receive Communion, then turn them off afterward.

**Adoration is open** between Masses with a limit of 100 persons in the church at a time.

**You are also welcome to visit the shrine and pray outdoors!** For your safety and the safety of others, please try to remain at least 6 feet apart from others and cover all sneezes and coughs.



St. Thomas Aquinas once defined Spiritual Communion as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament and in lovingly embracing Him as if we had actually received Him." You just need to approach Him with sincerity, humility and a desire to follow in His footsteps in acts of faith and charity. St. Jean-Marie Vianney, a French priest famous for converting countless souls to Christ in his parish of Ars in the 19th century, once said "when we feel the love of God growing cold, let us instantly make a Spiritual Communion. When we cannot go to the church, let us turn towards the tabernacle; no wall can shut us out from the good God."
