FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Transcendental Verum: What is Truth?

Dear Friends,

I wanted to dive back into our conversation on culture, as we get settled into the new year.

If you are able to remember, we ended with an introduction to the transcendentalists, truth, goodness, and beauty. And, in short, we said that they are based on reality itself.

Let's look at the first transcendental, Truth, and I think you will see why it is important. Well, I'd say, for us moderns, one of the most important questions of our age pertains to truth. In bygone ages, wise poets, philosophers, and thinkers have held the opinion, in common, that the truth exists and that it can be known. This has changed radically in the last few centuries and maybe even more dramatically in the last few decades. There are many who doubt truth exists, but even amongst those who accept truth – there is much disagreement that it is known or knowable. What does the Church think?

Let's start with truth itself. Actually, there are three kinds of truth. The first is truth in God. God, who is intellectual knows Himself and reflecting upon Himself perfectly conceives Himself. The infinite and eternal conception is the second person of the trinity, the Son. God is not a truth, He *is* the truth. Jesus is, indeed, the way the truth in the life.

The second kind of truth is the truth in beings. What this means is that God is the creator of all created reality and therefore creates them according to His design. In other words, when He causes a thing, it is exactly as He causes it. Therefore, it is false to say that we cannot know the truth or the mind of God; we simply have to look at reality, which is an expression of the mind of God. Truth in things is absolute. Things cannot be other than the way God causes them to be. Now, you may say, well we evidently disprove that, because of evil and things not going according to plan. God wills free-will in humans; the source of problems. Because we are free, we have the capacity to choose one thing or another, in accord with God's plan or not.

A third kind is the truth in our intellect. What does this mean? A simple working definition of truth in this last sense we can take from St. Thomas Aquinas. He explains that truth is the mind being in conformity with reality. When our senses are in good working order and our intellect is able to reason properly, we would say that we have the ability to make true judgments about reality. For example, if I am looking at the sky and say that it is blue there is a congruity between what is real (the sky) and in my mind.

We believe that Man tends by nature toward the truth. (CCC 2467) Therefore, even if we have fallen away from the truth, we have an obligation to pursue it. *We are bound to adhere to the truth once we come to know it and direct our whole life in accordance with the demands of truth.* (CCC 2467) Contrary to the belief of many contemporary secularists, the Church welcomes questions and the pursuit of wisdom via reason and science. For, we understand “both the light of reason and the light of faith come from God; hence there can be no contradiction between them.” (Aquinas, *Summa contra Gentiles*, I, 7)

We **oppose** the extremes. On one end of the spectrum we reject, *fideism*, which affirms that the fundamental act of human knowledge consists in an act of faith—as if to say “just believe and don't ask any questions about it”. And on the other end of the spectrum we reject the position of *scientism*, which relies solely upon experimental or empirical data—as if to say “if it cannot be measured it does not exist” or “everything real is reducible to matter”. The Church does not believe these extremes. The Church also rejects relativism. For one, its central claim “there is no truth” is self-refuting, but also, by relativizing everything one destroys all common ground. There are no objective criteria upon which any distinctions can be made, it becomes either a power struggle or populous movement to determine what is good or bad, true or false, ugly or beautiful. There is a fall into complete arbitrariness.

If human knowledge were rigorously limited to the world of sensible experience, that is, without a true metaphysical horizon (beyond the physical), it could never find the ultimate meaning of things and of man himself (our purpose, our end, the best way to get there). This is how St. John Paul II expresses it: “It is not possible to stop at experience alone; even when it expresses and reveals the interiority of man and his spirituality, it is necessary that speculative reflection reach its spiritual nature and the foundation on which it rests.”

MASS INTENTION REQUESTS

The calendar is currently open for Mass intention requests for the month of January 2021! (Please continue to check for updates as we adapt to new changes).

Please follow the **temporary** process listed below.

Although the parish office is closed to drop-in visitors, we have instituted a temporary process to accept and process Mass Intention requests via email. The normal Mass Intention guidelines listed below still apply, including the 25 character limit.

Mass Intention request requirements:

- Donation of \$10 per Mass
- Up to two (2) separate Masses that do not occur in the same week may be requested
- Each Mass may only have 2 names with a limit of 25 characters (including spaces) per Mass request, and only one intention option chosen (Birthday, Death Anniversary, Health, Special Intentions, Thanksgiving, or Wedding Anniversary). Please remember to note if the request is for someone living or deceased.
- No changes can be made once the requests have been placed into the calendar.
- No holds or reservations will be accepted. No exceptions can be made.

In order to request a Mass Intention during this shelter-in time, please carefully follow the steps below:

1. First, please send an email with your full name, phone number, Mass Intention request text (limit 25 characters), and preferred date/time to mass@olop-shrine.org. Please refer to the Mass Intention Requests form above to see what details you will need to provide.
2. Once the email is received, our staff will look through the calendar for availability. Until the intention request is finalized by a confirmation reply email from our staff, the intention is not considered entered in the calendar. **Due to the volume of requests, it is best to request a Mass intention at least one week prior to the desired date.**
3. If there is a time conflict with the requested date/time, our staff member will call you to arrange an alternative date and time. You will also receive a call if there are any changes needed to the request.
4. The confirmation email will give a link indicating how to submit your Mass Intention request donation online. This information & a sample request form can also be found online at bit.ly/olop-mass-requests

PARISH REGISTRATION

Are You a Registered Parishioner? If you attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace parish.

Three main reasons why registering is important:

1. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

2. Make Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

If you're not a registered parishioner, this may greatly delay the process for Sacrament prep.

3. Letters of Recommendation

There are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide this letter.

Anyone, regardless of where they live is welcome to register at OLOP.

Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork cannot not be processed within the 3 months. Please email info@olop-shrine.org for a registration form.

*In the event of inclement weather, we may need to move this Mass to the parking lot on a case by case basis--staff and volunteers will assist you. The Mass will still be livestreamed.

Masks are required on the property. Thank you for doing your part in protecting the health of our community.

Adoration is open between Masses with limited persons permitted in the church at a time..

Mass Outside the Church: Please form a line before Mass begins. Please follow the instructions of the volunteer ushers who will be helping direct you to your places.

- You are encouraged to bring your own chairs if sitting outside.
- You will be instructed to maintain a social distance between the households (6ft).
- Children must always remain under the close supervision of parents/family at all times.
- Please dress warmly and be prepared for weather changes!
- There is no reservation system for outdoor Mass.

Mass in the parking lot: The only entrance/exit will be from Our Lady's Way. There will be a security guard and volunteers who will direct you to your parking spots.

- Please stay in your vehicles at all times, unless you need to line up for confession or use the restroom. The restrooms that are designated for public use are only in the Family Learning Center.
- We will broadcast the Mass on an FM radio signal (92.9 FM) so that you can follow along from your vehicle.
- Due to county restrictions, Mass is limited to 100 cars only. Holy Communion ~~cannot be~~ *can be* distributed to those in their vehicles in the parking lot participating in the Mass.
- Please turn on your emergency blinker lights at the appropriate to indicate that you wish to receive Communion, then turn them off afterward.

You are also welcome to visit the shrine and pray outdoors! For your safety and the safety of others, please try to remain at least 6 feet apart from others and cover all sneezes and coughs.

What is a Spiritual Communion?

St. Thomas Aquinas once defined Spiritual Communion as "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament and in lovingly embracing Him as if we had actually received Him." You just need to approach Him with sincerity, humility and a desire to follow in His footsteps in acts of faith and charity. St. Jean-Marie Vianney, a French priest famous for converting countless souls to Christ in his parish of Ars in the 19th century, once said "when we feel the love of God growing cold, let us instantly make a Spiritual Communion. When we cannot go to the church, let us turn towards the tabernacle; no wall can shut us out from the good God."




If you lose an item, you can stop by the parish office (ring the doorbell) and give a description of your lost item. You can also email a description of the item to info@olop-shrine.org
