FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This Week: A Great Cloud of Witnesses

Dear Friends,

This week we have a line-up of saints' feast days that are worth highlighting. Here is what we have coming up: Monday, St. Francis de Sales; Tuesday, Conversion of St. Paul; Wednesday, Sts. Timothy and Titus; Thursday, St. Angela Merici; Friday, St. Thomas Aquinas. It's a power-packed week!

The saints are one of the important ways by which we can keep our eyes fixed on Christ and formed in the ways of the Gospel. Christ is the teacher; we can consider them to be something like tutors. There are so many sizes and shapes among the saints that it is difficult to find one that doesn't relate to me. In fact, I find that one of the most difficult questions that I am ever asked is, "which saint is your favorite?" I find this a particularly difficult one because each saint speaks to a different part of my life. This is an important part of the communion of saints, we can turn to them for inspiration and intercession for most all of our needs. It might be impossible to not find a saint whose life does not speak to a particular aspect or moment of my life.

I would like to present a sampling of what each of these saints, in the coming five days, will offer for our consideration.

St. Francis de Sales, Bishop and Doctor of the Church (known as "The Gentle Doctor")

"It is not those who commit the least faults who are the most holy, but those who have the greatest courage, the greatest generosity, the greatest love, who make the boldest efforts to overcome themselves, and are not immediately apprehensive about tripping."

Saint Paul's Conversion

"Paul, more than anyone else, has shown us what man really is, and in what our nobility consists, and of what virtue this particular animal is capable. Each day he aimed ever higher; each day he rose up with greater ardor and faced with new eagerness the dangers that threatened him. He summed up his attitude in the words: I forget what is behind me and push on to what lies ahead. [...] The most important thing of all to him, however, was that he knew himself to be loved by Christ. Enjoying this love, he considered himself happier than anyone else; were he without it, it would be no satisfaction to be the friend of principalities and powers. He preferred to be thus loved and be the least of all, or even to

be among the damned, than to be without that love and be among the great and honored." (St. John Chrysostom)

Saints Titus and Timothy, Bishops

"If we consider together the two figures of Timothy and Titus, we are aware of certain very significant facts. The most important one is that in carrying out his missions, Paul availed himself of collaborators. He certainly remains the Apostle par excellence, founder and pastor of many Churches. [...] Another observation concerns the willingness of these collaborators. The sources concerning Timothy and Titus highlight their readiness to take on various offices that also often consisted in representing Paul in circumstances far from easy. In a word, they teach us to serve the Gospel with generosity, realizing that this also entails a service to the Church herself." (Benedict XVI, On Sts. Timothy & Titus)

St. Angela Merici, Virgin

"Do not lose heart, even if you should discover that you lack qualities necessary for the work to which you are called. He who called you will not desert you, but the moment you are in need he will stretch out his saving hand."

St. Thomas Aquinas, Priest and Doctor

(Speaking about the Mass) "O precious and wonderful banquet, that brings us salvation and contains all sweetness! Could anything be of more intrinsic value? Under the old law it was the flesh of calves and goats that was offered, but here Christ himself, the true God, is set before us as our food. What could be more wonderful than this? No other sacrament has greater healing power; through it sins are purged away, virtues are increased, and the soul is enriched with an abundance of every spiritual gift. It is offered in the Church for the living and the dead, so that what was instituted for the salvation of all may be for the benefit of all. Yet, in the end, no one can fully express the sweetness of this sacrament, in which spiritual delight is tasted at its very source, and in which we renew the memory of that surpassing love for us which Christ revealed in his passion."

May the saints continue to intercede for all of us and bring us to a deeper love of God and neighbor.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Are You a Registered Parishioner?

If you are over the age of 18 and attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace parish.

Three main reasons why registering is important:

1. Make Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

Infant baptisms, religious education registration, being a godparent/sponsor for baptisms or confirmations, and especially getting married (whether you are getting married at this parish, another parish, or having an international Catholic wedding) all involve record of parish participation. If you're not a registered parishioner, this will greatly delay the process.

23. Letters of Recommendation

Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide this letter to you or your family.

3. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

This includes single people or young families who may not see the need to register.

Anyone, regardless of where they live (even though the Diocese is divided into parish geographical areas), **is welcome to register at OLOP.**

Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork will not be processed within the 3 months.

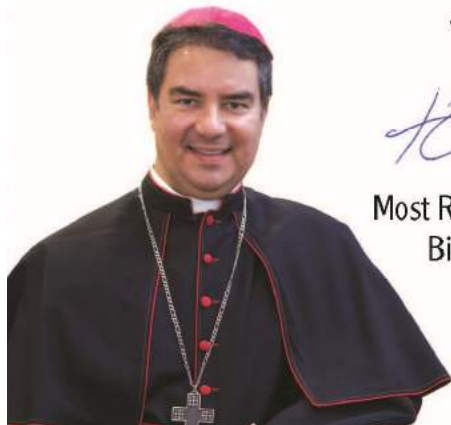

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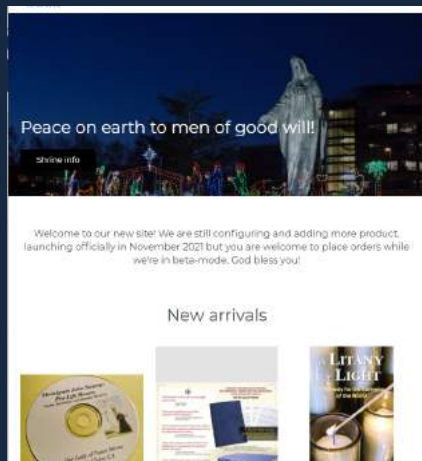
