FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Are the Acts of the Apostles Your Acts as Well?"

Dear Friends,

Liturgically, we are still in Eastertide. We are also anticipating or looking towards the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. This also reminds us that as a parish we are anticipating the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation. In fact, we will have the privilege of welcoming Bishop Oscar Cantú to Our Lady of Peace this coming Thursday, May 19, 2022.

Also, as we approach the Solemnity of Pentecost, I want you to consider or recall your own confirmation. Where was it? How old were you? What has changed in your life from them until now? Are you more deeply conformed to the life of Christ? If so, in what ways? If not, where are some areas for improvement?

Unfortunately, there is a common way of proposing confirmation to youth as, "this is the time in which you are free to accept your faith as an adult." I think that this is misleading, even though it might be well-intentioned. Why is this misleading? Well, I think that it shifts the focus away from what the sacrament truly gives to us and their purpose. To the former, we are given the gifts of the Holy Spirit. To the latter, we are given them so that our lives may be conformed to that of Jesus Christ. We are given help, by God Himself, to be like God. Here is what the Catechism teaches:

"It is evident from its celebration that the effect of the sacrament of Confirmation is the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost." (n. 1302)

Ultimately, the conviction to accept Jesus Christ as my Savior, teacher, and guide, is a daily task. The reduction of confirmation to a "free acceptance moment" tempts us into seeing this sacrament as a finish line. It is treated as the last stop on the "sacramental prep line." Then the kids are free to stop going to church, just like the majority of their parents. This is the sad reality.

Now, to be clear, I don't think that the only reason for this is centered upon one's misconception of the sacrament of Confirmation. There are many factors, but this may very well be one of them. Our behaviors and customs begin with ideas and these ideas lead to attitudes that influence our behaviors.

So, an honest and worthwhile question that we all may take up is, if we want to consider our Christian lives under the light of "freely accepted adult level discipleship," how is my discipleship? To what can I compare it? How about if we compare our lives to early Christians in the Acts of the Apostles? Do you see yourself there? Is your life like theirs? Are your hopes and fears, joys and sorrows like theirs? Holy Mother Church in her wisdom has us read through the Acts of the Apostles immediately after Easter. After the apostles and disciples received the power of the Holy Spirit they were changed. Their whole entire existence was dedicated to Jesus Christ. Indeed, they chose Him, but this was not a "one and done" deal. It was the beginning of a new life. Again from the Catechism:

"Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

It roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!";

It unites us more firmly to Christ;

It increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us

It renders our bond with the Church more perfect;

It gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross. (How about this last one!?!)

We can unwittingly undergo the reverse process of maturation in thinking that the sacrament of confirmation is the point of arrival. It's sort of like a child who thinks staying up late, choosing when I want to eat and doing what I want and having money on my pocket makes me a grown up.

We are all called to holiness. This is the Christian vocation. (Cf. Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 1533). There is no other path to holiness than Jesus Christ. The sacrament of Confirmation and the gifts of the Holy Spirit help us to confirm sanctifying grace received at baptism, enabling us to conform our lives to the life of Christ. Our daily effort in this process is necessary. Now to be clear, our effort is not sufficient—we need God's help to be holy—but it is necessary.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Are You a Registered Parishioner?

If you are over the age of 18 and attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace parish.

Three main reasons why registering is important:

1. Make Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

Infant baptisms, religious education registration, being a godparent/sponsor for baptisms or confirmations, and especially getting married (whether you are getting married at this parish, another parish, or having an international Catholic wedding) all involve record of parish participation. If you're not a registered parishioner, this will greatly delay the process.

2. Letters of Recommendation

Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide this letter to you or your family.

3. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

This includes single people or young families who may not see the need to register.

Anyone, regardless of where they live (even though the Diocese is divided into parish geographical areas), **is welcome to register at OLOP.**

Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork will not be processed within the 3 months.

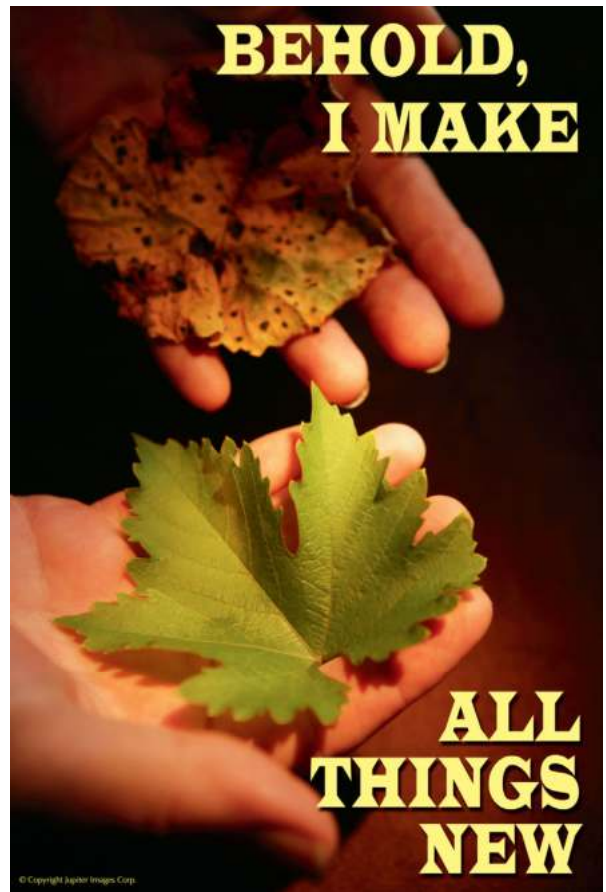
Position Summary:

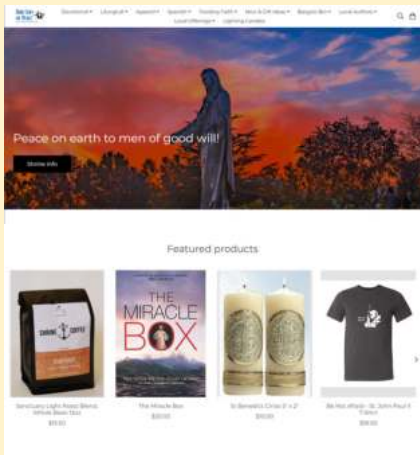

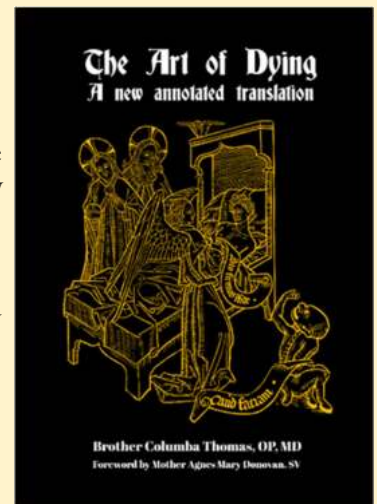
