

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Do Not Let Your Hearts Be Troubled"

Dear Friends,

There are many causes for concern in our world and in our lives, both socially and personally, as troubling situations affect each and every one of us collectively and individually. The causes for concern are many, food, money, health, peace, we do not know whose voice to listen to, one expert contradicts the other, one web page says one thing and the next web page says the opposite, and the root of this cause for trouble is uncertainty.

I would like to offer a question however to provide us with, what I think to be, some important perspective. What is more troubling: to know that there is cause for concern and to live our lives accordingly; or to not know that there is cause for concern and for us to go on about our lives not paying attention to it or realizing it? This would need to be followed up with another question: what is truly a cause for concern? So, to repeat this as a statement, I would say that it is more troubling to live our lives, in tranquility and comfort, as if there were no causes for concern, when in fact there truly is (cause for concern).

Remember, Jesus is God.

Time and again Jesus says, "Do not be afraid." Jesus Christ is telling us today do not be troubled, He is our certainty. Perhaps there is nothing more certain than the statement "I AM." When He said this, for those who heard it, there was no mistake about what he meant. He is God.

In Saint John's Gospel, Jesus uses many different titles and images to describe himself. "I am the bread of life" he says. "I am the resurrection and the life," "I am the Way, the truth, and the life" There are eight of these "I AM" statements found in John's Gospel. "I am the gate for the sheep," and "I am the Way, the Truth, and the life." Everything the Savior does for us is for this purpose: to show us the Father, to reconcile us with the Father, to lead us to the Father, that we may be with him and his Father in paradise forever.

He desires our conversion.

Whether you realize it or not, whether you remember it or not, you and I have vowed ourselves to this path at baptism. A promise of utmost importance, one that identifies God's consideration of us – friends, sons and daughters by adoption, worthy of His love, a love so deep that it meant sending his only Son, so that we may participate in the

Divine life. From the side of God to us, He has shown us the trouble that He was willing to go through out of fidelity towards us.

Time and again, however, we mistakenly place more attention, energy and confidence in worldly things and dismiss the things of God as irrelevant to immediate needs. St. John Henry Newman describes this situation well. He says, "The world sweeps by in long procession; its principalities and powers, its Babel of languages, the astrologers, the horse and its rider and the chariots of Egypt, Baal, and Ashtoreth, and their false worship; and those who witness, feel its fascination; they flock after it; with a strange fancy, they imitate its gestures, and dote over its mummeries (repeat their empty slogans)." And then Newman says, when we hear the truths of the Gospel such as: "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life;" "Be sober, be vigilant;" "Strait is the gate, narrow the way;" "If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself;"—how utterly unreal do these appear, and the preachers of them, how irrational, how childish and small-minded?!"

So, how do we keep this going?

And we can ask with St. Louis de Montfort, "But does anyone keep this great vow? Does anyone fulfil the promises of baptism faithfully? Is it not true that nearly all Christians prove unfaithful to the promises made to Jesus in baptism? Where does this universal failure come from, if not from man's habitual forgetfulness of the promises and responsibilities of baptism and from the fact that scarcely anyone makes a personal ratification of the contract made with God through his sponsors?"

St. Louis de Montfort will encourage us to turn to God with Mary. Devotion to Mary could rightly be called a perfect renewal of the vows and promises of holy baptism. Before baptism every Christian was a slave of the devil because he belonged to him. He teaches us to renounce the devil, the world, sin and self, as expressed in the act of consecration, and we give ourselves entirely to Jesus through Mary.

May the Blessed Virgin Mary, Our Lady of Peace, help us to keep our hearts and minds fixed on God. May she take us by the hand and lead us to seek wholeheartedly that supernatural charity flowing forth from the wounded side of the Crucified One.



PARISH REGISTRATION

Are You a Registered Parishioner?

If you are over the age of 18 and attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace parish.

Three main reasons why registering is important:

1. Make Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

Infant baptisms, religious education registration, being a godparent/sponsor for baptisms or confirmations, and especially getting married (whether you are getting married at this parish, another parish, or having an international Catholic wedding) all involve record of parish participation. If you're not a registered parishioner, this will greatly delay the process.

2. Letters of Recommendation

Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide

this letter to you or your family.

3. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

This includes single people or young families who may not see the need to register.

Anyone, regardless of where they live (even though the Diocese is divided into parish geographical areas), is welcome to register at OLOP.

Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork will not be processed within the 3 months.

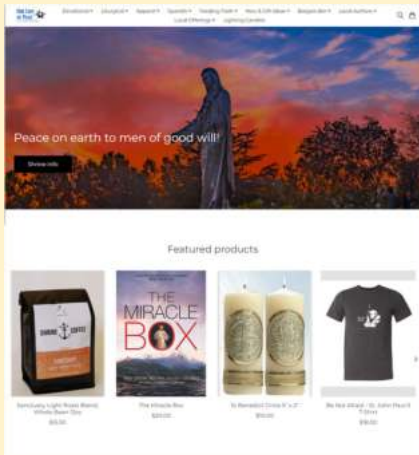

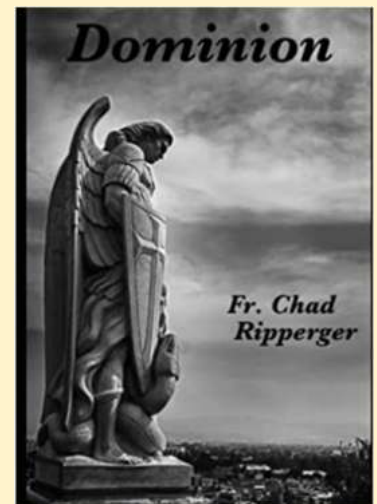

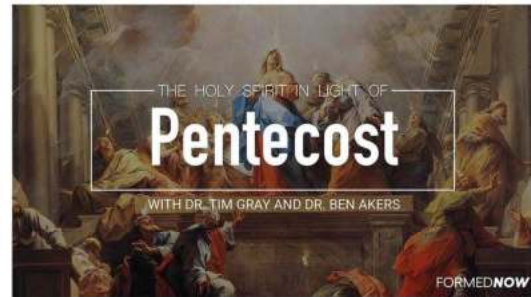
