FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

The Great Unknown

Dear Friends,

In the time of St. Paul, the Athenians offered worship to the "Unknown God." (Acts 17,23) When visiting Ephesus, St. Paul met some disciples (people already converted to the Christian faith). He asked them, "Did you receive the holy Spirit when you became believers?" They had never heard of this. In other words, they did not really know. (Acts 19,1-2)

Every time we profess the creed we say, "I believe in the Holy Spirit". What does this mean?

There are many Christians who pray the Creed and repeat this affirmation but do not know much about the Holy Spirit. Now, suppose St. Paul would come back and ask similar questions, chances are the great majority of Christians would reply similarly. Why? Well, maybe, in part, because the manifestations of the Holy Spirit are not as sensible, but they are spiritual. Perhaps, it is a lack of doctrinal formation and understanding. It could also be a lack of devotion. There are many devotions related to our Lord, the Blessed Mother, but not so frequently does one find devotion to the Holy Spirit.

To say "I believe in the Holy Spirit" is to profess that the Holy Spirit is one of the persons of the Holy Trinity; more precisely, the third person. He is God, like the Father and like the Son; he deserves the same adoration as the Father and the Son; like the Father and the Son He is creator, maker of all things, sanctifier. That is why when we make the sign of the cross, we sanctify ourselves in the name of each of the three persons of the Trinity, and when we pray the Gloria we name each of the three persons of the Blessed Trinity.

Moreover, just as we attribute the creation of the world and of man to God the Father and just as we attribute the Redemption to God the Son made man (Jesus Christ), so, there are some works that are attributed to the Holy Spirit, and which reveal the nature of His mission towards us. In the New Testament he is given several names that show us this:

-Jesus Christ calls him "the Paraclete," which means "comforter." (Jn 14-16) In our sufferings, in our tribulations, it is the Holy Spirit who consoles us. That is why one of the ancient hymns of the Church sings: cleanse what is unclean, water what is barren, heal what is wounded. (Veni Sancte Spiritus)

-Advocate: because he defends us. St. Paul says: "the Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; when we do not know what prayer to offer, to pray as we ought, the Spirit himself intercedes for us, with groans beyond all utterance." (Rom 8:26).

-Spirit of promise: "against all human hope, God promises descendants to Abraham, as the fruit of faith and the power of the Holy Spirit. [...] God commits himself by his own solemn oath to giving his beloved Son and "the promised Holy Spirit who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it." (CCC 706)

-Spirit of Truth: because it is He who makes the Apostles remember all that Jesus Christ said, and it is He who makes Christians and especially the Pope understand the Holy Scriptures without error.

-Sanctifier: because he is the one who produces holiness in our hearts; he stirs up in our hearts the virtues and good qualities that make us holy and pleasing to God. That is why St. Paul says that "the spirit yields a harvest of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, forbearance, gentleness, faith, courtesy, temperateness, purity." (Gal 5:22-23).

We cannot be Christians if we do not know the Holy Spirit. And we cannot be good Christians if we do not devoutly love the Holy Spirit, if we do not invoke Him and if we do not rejoice when He, through grace, dwells in our hearts.

Remember that the Holy Spirit that descends upon us in the silence of our soul—without great noise and clamor. Some expect great events, given the fact that when He descended the first time He came with "strong wind and tongues of fire." And so, why not now? It is possible, but perhaps it is not necessary. At that time, the sign of fire and wind were necessary for those to believe; but blessed are those who believe without seeing, that is why now it is not necessary. (Jn 20:29) It is not in the noise where the Holy Spirit is, but in the silence. God speaks quietly and softly, in a "still small voice." (1 Kings 19:11-12)

PARISH REGISTRATION

Are You a Registered Parishioner?

If you are over the age of 18 and attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace parish.

Three main reasons why registering is important:

1. Make Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

Infant baptisms, religious education registration, being a godparent/sponsor for baptisms or confirmations, and especially getting married (whether you are getting married at this parish, another parish, or having an international Catholic wedding) all involve record of parish participation. If you're not a registered parishioner, this will greatly delay the process.

2. Letters of Recommendation

Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide

this letter to you or your family.

3. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

This includes single people or young families who may not see the need to register.

Anyone, regardless of where they live (even though the Diocese is divided into parish geographical areas), is welcome to register at OLOP.

Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork will not be processed within the 3 months.

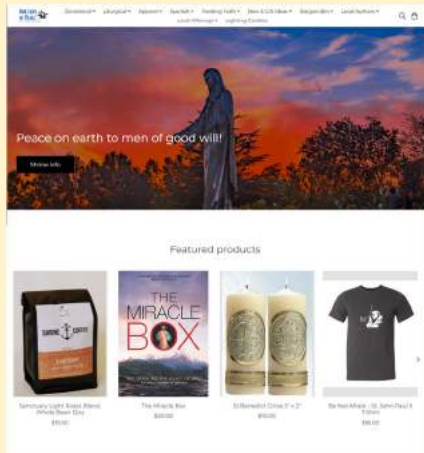

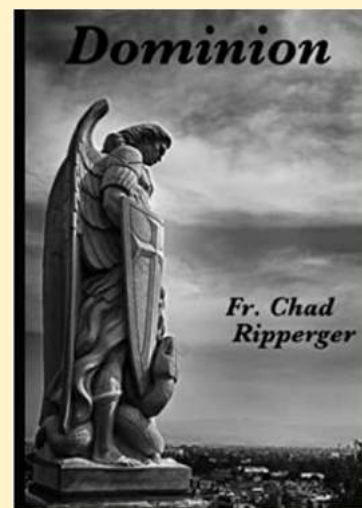
