## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### *Reclaiming the Ordinary – Prudence Improves Communication*

Dear Friends,

I wanted to offer a continuation on last week's piece regarding the Cardinal Virtue of Prudence. There is a nice book by a Catholic Psychiatrist whose name is Richard P. Fitzgibbons, M.D. that speaks about the cardinal virtues within the context of relationships and in particular marriage. The name of the book is "Habits for a Healthy Marriage: A Handbook for Catholic Couples." The lessons that he provides, particularly regarding the virtues are helpful for relationships of any form. Therefore, I would like to turn to his wisdom in order to provide some practical applications to the theory that we introduced last week.

Dr. Fitzgibbons appeals to the virtue of prudence as a key to resolving communication conflicts. He first appeals to the Catechism of the Catholic Church for a definition of the virtue: "Prudence is the virtue that disposes practical reason to discern our true good in every circumstance and to choose the right means of achieving it" (CCC 1806).

Prudence, he says, helps us "to see what is to be done, or said, in a given situation." In other words, knowing when and how to say certain things. Prudence will be an art of listening and speaking well—the two components of communication. Doing them well depends upon the context (persons, places, things, circumstances, etc.). Prudence helps us to determine what is needed for the moment.

I would like to quote Dr. Fitzgibbons here at length:

Prudence and Vital Communication Issues Let us consider the role prudence plays in three important aspects of good marital communication: (1) the style, or emotional tone, of the communication; (2) the content of the communication; and (3) the time spouses set aside for communication.

Communication Style The communication style, or emotional tone, is as important as—and sometimes more important than—the content of a marital discussion. If words are not spoken in a loving and respectful manner, the spouse who hears them often becomes defensive and will not be able to receive what is communicated. Emotional tone, facial expression, and responsiveness are vital aspects of conversation and should reflect a deep love for one's spouse.

When one focuses on being cheerful, trusting, and forgiving, one's facial expression and tone of voice are usually kind and loving.

Saint John Chrysostom's prudent advice for husbands on how to communicate with their wives contains timeless

wisdom: "Whenever you give your wife advice, always begin by telling her how much you love her. Nothing will persuade her so well to admit the wisdom of your words as her assurance that you are speaking to her with sincere affection. Tell her. .. that you love her more than gold."<sup>3</sup> The same, of course, is true for wives offering advice to their husbands.

Working on maintaining a loving and respectful communication style is demanding but immensely rewarding for a marriage and for children. Past forgiveness exercises for previous hurts from one's spouse or family of origin are often part of the necessary work.

Attentive listening and responding are key to good marital communication. The ability to listen respectfully is an essential aspect of receiving one's spouse, of self-surrender, and of successful transition from the self-absorbed "me" to the "we" of mature marital love.

Listening is vital to the process of self-surrender because it removes some of the obstacles to unity, such as our proud self-reliance and independent thinking. Listening helps us to recognize that we do not have all the answers and to appreciate more what others have to offer. Some spouses report that they listen better when they think, "My spouse wants only the best for me, the children, and others." Others report being helped by asking them-selves, "What is the Lord saying to me now through my spouse?" Also helpful is Saint James' prudent advice that everyone "be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger" (Jas 1:19).

Caring spouses want to help each other find solutions to problems.

Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen's observation about endurance in marriage has assisted many couples in seeking greater closeness through helping one another on the journey of personal growth:

"One of the greatest mistakes couples make is to think that their love will endure because it is strong. Rather, love continues not because of its strength but because it is related to the power of self-renewal. The love of a husband and wife is less a continuing thing than it is, like Calvary and the Resurrection, the finding of new life at a moment when it was believed that satiety was the master. In family life, two hearts do not move on a roadway prudence improves communication to a happier love; rather, every now and then they seem on the brink of losing their love, only to find it on a higher level." (Ven. Fulton Sheen, *It Takes Three to Get*

**LENT: FASTING & ABSTINENCE**

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting.

From its earliest days, the Church has urged the baptized and the catechumens to observe the threefold discipline of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer as a preparation for the celebration of Easter. Failure to observe individual days of penance is not considered serious, but failure to observe any penitential days at all or a substantial number of such days must be considered serious.

During Lent, the Church encourages attendance at daily Mass, self-imposed times of fasting, and generosity to local, national, and worldwide programs of sharing.

## PARISH REGISTRATION

### Are You a Registered Parishioner?

If you are over the age of 18 and attend Mass here regularly, we encourage you to register as a member of Our Lady of Peace parish.

### Three main reasons why registering is important:

#### 1. Make Sacrament prep easier when the time comes.

Infant baptisms, religious education registration, being a godparent/sponsor for baptisms or confirmations, and especially getting married (whether you are getting married at this parish, another parish, or having an international Catholic wedding) all involve record of parish participation. If you're not a registered parishioner, this will greatly delay the process.

#### 2. Letters of Recommendation

Sometimes there are occasions where letters of recommendations are needed from your parish pastor (ie Catholic school enrollment, scholarships, godparent eligibility, etc.). If you're not registered, we cannot provide

this letter to you or your family.

#### 3. If we as a parish do not know who is out there, how can we serve the needs of all?

This includes single people or young families who may not see the need to register.

Anyone, regardless of where they live (even though the Diocese is divided into parish geographical areas), is welcome to register at OLOP.

Please note: there is a three (3) month waiting period from the date of registration before being considered a full-fledged registered parishioner. Any requests for pastor signatures on any forms, letters, or wedding preparation paperwork will not be processed within the 3 months.


