

Today We Celebrate The Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Last year Pope Francis wrote: "Our prayer cannot be reduced to an hour on Sundays. It is important to have a daily relationship with the Lord." (@pontifex, 10/17/13). And then, this year: "Through the Eucharist, Christ wishes to enter into our life and permeate it with His grace, so that in every Christian community there may be coherence between liturgy and life." (Pope Francis, 02/12/14)

Then, continuing with the teachings of St. John Paul II in his Apostolic Letter *Dies Domini*, I'd like to propose for your consideration the idea that Sunday Mass is not just an event but a reality that should be lived throughout, all the days of our life.

Dies Domini clearly states: "Until quite recently, it was easier in traditionally Christian countries to keep Sunday holy because it was an almost universal practice and because, even in the organization of civil society, Sunday rest was considered a fixed part of the work schedule. Today, however, even in those countries which give legal sanction to the festive character of Sunday, changes in socio-economic conditions have often led to profound modifications of social behavior and hence of the character of Sunday. The custom of the "weekend" has become more widespread, a weekly period of respite, spent perhaps far from home and often involving participation in cultural, political or sporting activities which are usually held on free days. This social and cultural phenomenon is by no means without its positive aspects if, while respecting true values, it can contribute to people's development and to the advancement of the life of society as a whole. All of this responds not only to the need for rest, but also to the need for celebration which is inherent in our humanity."

"Unfortunately, when Sunday loses its fundamental meaning and becomes merely part of a "weekend." We need to reaffirm the conviction that the religious significance of Sunday is not in opposition to the human values which make Sunday a time of rest, of enjoying nature and of more relaxed social relations."

The Holy Pope then points out that our weekly rest should be seen essentially in relation to God, to celebrate His saving works, a time to rediscover the values of the spirit, dialogue and solidarity with others, to lighten the burden of daily concerns, to discover a new joy and hope (cf. 67,83,84). Well understood, Christian rest is therefore distinct from the "weekend," it is not just any kind of interruption of work (17) but a way of keeping the Lord's Day holy, and the "weekend" as a time of simple rest and relaxation.

This certainly requires a genuine spiritual maturity, which will enable us to "be what [we] are", in full accordance with the gift of faith we have received. In this way, we will be led to a deeper understanding of Sunday, with the result that, even in difficult situations, we will be able to live it in complete docility to the Holy Spirit.

Hence, taking part in Sunday Mass is not only an important obligation, but first and foremost a profound need for each one of our souls. We Christians cannot live a life dissociated from the mystery of the Eucharist. "Let Sunday Mass become for us the climax of every week." (St. John Paul II, *Angelus* 1979)

The Church repeatedly calls families to be assiduous in attending Sunday Mass. For by drinking at the source of this love, the family will protect its own stability. Let your family's faith grow and develop with the beautiful experience of attending Mass together. You will see how in the end, it will give meaning to ordinary life and infuse peace in the heart.

As we take advantage of our vacation days to spend time with our loved ones and to rest from the everyday demands and routines of work, let us not neglect to also "rest in the Lord" on the day in which we commemorate his love for us in the Sunday Eucharist.

OLOP Window Stickers may help officers recognize church goers when directing traffic for the stadium. Registered parishioners will receive theirs in the mail by August 2. You can also pick one up at the rectory starting July 15 (one per family please). Please keep the traffic in mind when coming to OLOP (fans arrive early for tailgating and it will take 2 hours to clear a full stadium).

Consider alternate routes and plan ahead!

Parking:

Official stadium parking spots will be available within a 2 mile radius of the stadium (see map). To ensure our parking is only for parishioners on event days, it will be limited to 3-hours and monitored by a security team. However, if you need to be here longer, please ask the guard to extend your visit by 3 more hours! We ask your understanding and patience in the next couple of months as we all learn how traffic will be impacted.

Violators to parking limitations are subject to towing per city ordinance.
